### **TREASURERS REPORT 2007/2008**

Last year was very quiet for me with no major projects or incidents to contend with.

Committee and club members especially David Moore, David Smith and Peter Champion did most of the maintenance at the club and I just paid the bills.

On the income side Richard, James, Mary, Carolyn, Brenda and Peter have run beginners courses and have a go's earning the club £2800 of income, and on behalf of the club I would like to thank them, and all other club members who have helped in many ways. It is very much appreciated.

I will now explain the two sheets you have. First the Summary Sheet.

The 1<sup>st</sup> column shows the income that has been paid into the club in the last financial year.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> column shows the expenditure of the club.

And the 3<sup>rd</sup> is the summary of the accounts giving the income that we have made for club funds and also showing the total money that is in the club at present.

As you can see the accounts are in a very healthy state. The committee wanted to buy something that would be of benefit to all club members, so we have decided to buy 3 benches that will be placed on the field for members to use and enjoy.

#### **The budget sheet.**

I would like to explain the reasons for some of the large differences in what we budgeted for last year.

On the income side the equipment and ground hire was higher because Rivernook hired some bosses for their 70m shoot and also Surrey County are paying us more to hold the 2 longbow shoots on our ground.

Things like Have a Go's we are always conservative with the figures I put in, because it is not something we can rely on.

There may not be any income from WAC Open this year for reasons that Peter C will explain later.

#### Expenditure

Trophies and medals were double what we estimated because we had to buy a quantity of black badges which should last us for some years, and also 4 new clout trophies. Also with regards to archery equipment we had the opportunity to buy 4 new damage bosses and stands @ £150 each instead of £300 each.

This year the committee proposes to refurb the kitchen to make it more difficult or if possible impossible for the mice to get in.

Finish off the new storage area behind the kitchen.

Repaint all of the sheds and hopefully finish off the road.

We are always looking for new projects so if any members have any ideas on improvements we can make to the club, please come and talk to any committee member.

Following completion of the accounts, Brenda found out yesterday that GNAS will be increasing their affiliations by £1 for seniors and £2 for juniors. This means that in contradiction to the budget sheet I have given you this afternoon membership fees will be £81 for senior members and £47 for junior members. (Amended Budget Sheet attached) I would once again like to point out that the club part of the fees is only £42.50 and £24. (This includes £2 that we have to pay to Wisley Sports and Social Club). This is for being able to shoot 365 days a year if you want.

Finally I would just like to say that this year will be my last year as Treasurer. I would like to thank everybody for their support over the last 6 years.
