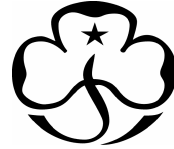

Where does the procession go?

Albert Road, Central Avenue, Bridgford Road, Millicent Road and Musters Road. Here the Scouts, Guides, Explorers and Rangers will go into Friary Church and the remaining units will continue to Musters Road Methodist Church.

What time do the services start?

3.00pm

What happens on the way back to the Park?

The lead band will reform at the end of William Road near Millicent Road. The procession will form up as per the reverse of this sheet

The Mayor and other dignitaries will be by the croquet Lawn in Central Avenue.

What about my parents and friends?

Parent and friends are very welcome to watch the procession but unfortunately, due to lack of space, there will be no room for them in the churches.
