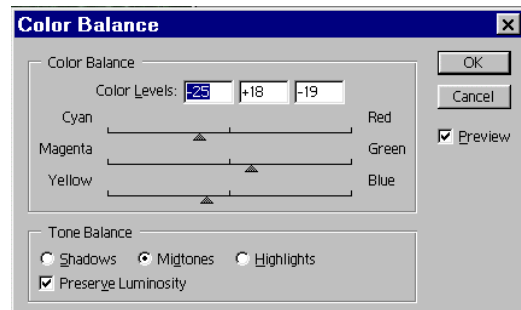
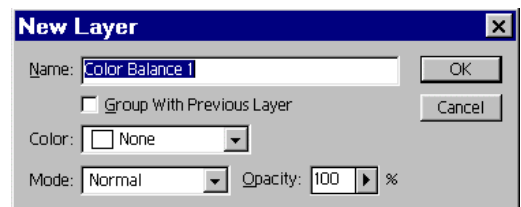
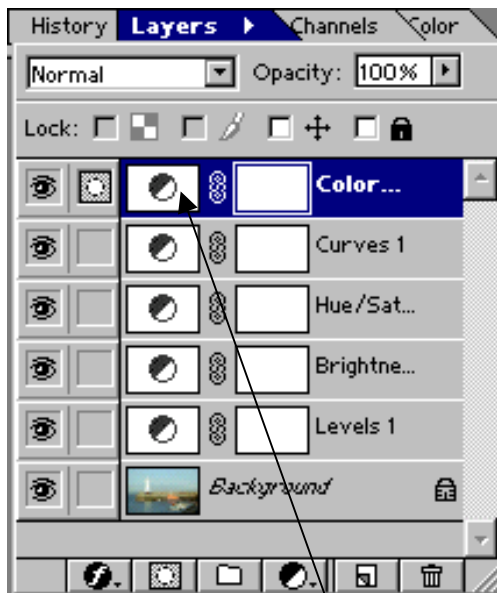

Adjustment Layers

Where tonal and/or color corrections to an image are to be made these are best carried out using adjustment layers as each specific adjustment layer can be reactivated with the settings last used and amended accordingly

1. Levels – select layer, new adjustment layer, levels
2. Curves – select layer, new adjustment layer, curves
3. Color balance – select layer, new adjustment, color balance
4. Brightness/contrast – select layer, new adjustment, brightness/contrast
5. Hue/saturation – select layer, new adjustment, hue/saturation



Double click on layer to reactivate

In addition to tonal and color corrections there are numerous other adjustments that can be applied to an image such as layer styles and blending options and these are best experimented with to see what effect they have on a specific image
