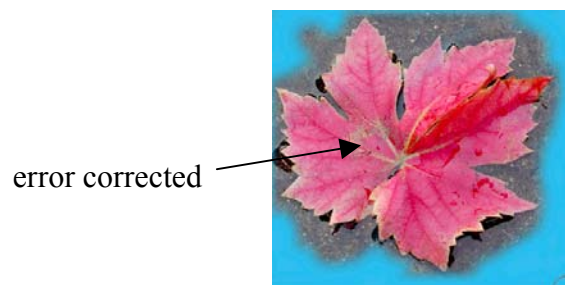
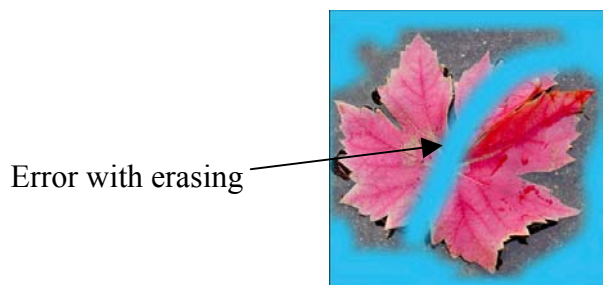
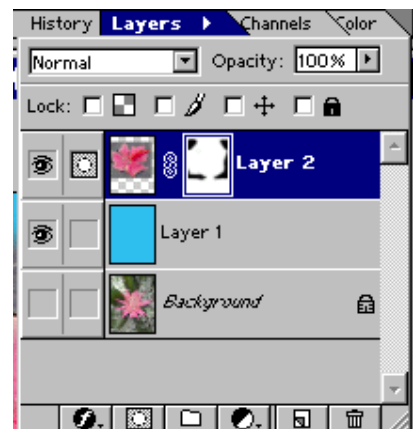
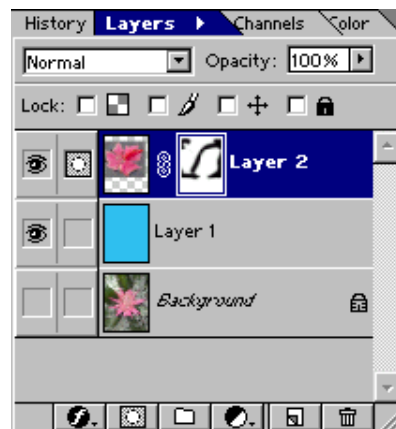


# Photoshop 6

## Montage

By layer mask – The advantage of this method is that all of the painting tools and their options are available when erasing



1. Open an image and using the lasso tool or other suitable tool make a selection that is to be copied to the clipboard
  2. Create a layer on the image and fill it with a color to create a mask
  3. Create a new layer and paste the copied image into it
  4. Create a layer mask by clicking on the quick mask icon
  5. Select the eraser tool and erase the portions of the image that are not required. Switching the foreground and background colors can reverse any mistakes made during erasing
- 
1. Select a base image for the montage or open a new blank image, select window, tile to enable both images to be seen side by side.
  2. Select the image which is required within the montage copy and move the required image into the base image and using edit, transform the selection can be resized to suit the montage
  3. Additional images can be added to the montage in a similar manner as above
