## Resizing & Reshaping

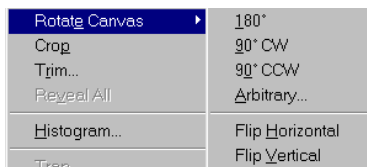
Crop & rotate



The crop tool can be used to select an area to remove unwanted areas of an image, the image to be cropped can be resized by selecting the horizontal or vertical handles and drawing them in or out as required, the handles at the corners can also be used to resize the image or to rotate it as required. To undo a crop select edit undo crop or control + z

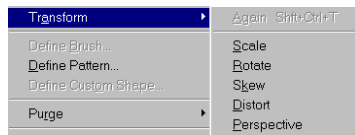
Transform whole image - Select by image, rotate canvas

The image can then be flipped horizontal, vertical, 90 degree clockwise, 90-degree counter clockwise, 180 degree or any arbitrary value as may be required. To undo select undo or control + z



Transform part of an image – Select part of image to be transformed then edit transform

The image can then be scaled, rotated, skewed, distorted or its perspective adjusted. To undo select undo or control + z



Distortion and perspective – Select the image or part of an image then edit transform or free transform. The image can then be scaled, rotated, skewed, distorted or its perspective adjusted. To undo select undo or control + z
