Minutes of the Meeting Dated Monday 13th March 2006
Held @ Denbury Village Hall – 7.30pm

Present – Mr B Clatworthy (Chairman), Mrs J Loynes, Jo Davison (Newton Town FC), Mr N Hughes, Mr A Boon, Dr S Hickey.

Apologies – Mr C Bottoms.

Attended by – Treasurer and Secretary of NTFC.

This meeting replaced the last meeting called on Monday 20th February 06 which had to be cancelled.

- 1) Minutes of the last meeting dated Monday 3rd October 2006 have been distributed and read. Proposed by Mrs J Loynes and seconded by Mr A Boon. They were duly signed by the Chairman – Mr B Clatworthy.
- 2) **Correspondence**
 - a) Donation from Mrs M Bailey £283.00 (Thanks letter to be sent and decision on how to best use the donation). A tree will be planted and some new swing seats to be ordered. Possibly the remainder of the money to be used towards another piece of play equipment for the smaller children.
 - b) Various Play Equipment Leaflets – Given to Chairman – Cllr B Clatworthy.
 - c) The Playing Field – Winter 05-06 – Given to Chairman – Cllr B Clatworthy.
 - d) Letter from Denbury AFC – A letter has been received confirming their wish to take over the Licence on the Field on a yearly basis once NTFC Licence finishes in August, they have offered to do the maintenance work needed with local people helping. Jo Davison from NTFC confirmed that Denbury AFC are not affiliated to the league but their members are affiliated to NTFC.
- 3) **Matters Arising**
 - a) New Seats for the Swings – The Chair seats have been fixed up and 2 new flat seats will now be ordered.
 - b) Childrens Play Area Fencing – Some quotations have been received and the TDC Rural Aid Grant forms have been completed and sent off.
 - c) Rotten Fencing Posts – These posts are against the sewerage plant road and are falling down – they are made of concrete and so are quite dangerous and very heavy. The Clerk will write to the Prison to try and ascertain ownership.
 - d) Litter on Field – NTFC – Jo Davison confirmed that the skip had been removed as it was being overfilled. The problem of Rubbish left behind is being addressed, Managers have been asked to make sure their rubbish is taken home each time teams play.
- 4) **Report from Newton Town FC** – Jo Davison reported that another award had been received this year for their Girls Team. Most teams have nearly finished but the under 8's have 10 weeks to go. The Girls Football Club will be hosted by NTFC. Jo confirmed that she would be stepping down in May at the AGM on 5th May 06 also the Senior Manager would be replaced. The Junior Football is what brings in revenue for the Club. NTFC have decided not to pursue the 25 year Lease Option, as just having it on the buildings did not offer enough control on the field which was needed.
- 5) **Cricket Club Report** – Dr S Hickey reported – Thanks to NTFC for keeping the grounds in a good state, the Cricket Club could not function without this. The Winter nets are carrying on the Club has some new members including youngsters with 26 games organised through the season.

Proposed new practice net is not yet done currently in negotiation with Matt Fice to put down the concrete pad in the Spring.
