## RULES

---

- 1 The Competition Secretary must be in receipt of correct remittance before entry is accepted. No telephone entries will be accepted.
- 2 Late entries will only be accepted where places are available and at the discretion of the organisers. A £2 surcharge per class is due on late entries.
- 3 British Riding Club rules will apply unless otherwise stated.
- 4 The organisers have the right to alter/amalgamate/cancel classes.
- 5 The organisers have the right to decline any entry and to ask any entry combination thought to be competing at the wrong level to compete H.C. or to move up a level.
- 6 Where classes are split into sections, the horse/pony may only compete in one section.
- 7 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placed horse and rider combinations in a qualifying class will qualify for the Championships – disregarding those already qualified.
- 8 Only qualifying horse and rider combinations may take part in the Championships.
- 9 A horse/rider combination can only qualify for one level of the Championships, with the exception of Elementary when they can also qualify at Medium, and Medium when they can also qualify at Advanced Medium. ***If a horse/rider combination qualifies for both the Prelim and Novice Championships, they cannot compete in the Prelim Championships.***
- 10 Horse/rider combinations placed 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup> in a previous NERC Prelim/Novice Championship or points league are not eligible to compete at that level in this series.
- 11 **Classes over-subscribed will be restricted.** Competitors may be restricted to riding a maximum of two tests per day, if entered in more than two tests or with more than one horse. Entries will be balloted out as follows:
  - i. Late entries
  - ii. Non-members
  - iii. Haut concours (HC) entries
  - iv. Members who have not helped at a NERC event
  - v. Competitors riding more than one horse and/or more than two tests
  - vi. Members already qualified for the Championship
  - vii. Members on first-come-first-served basis.
- 12 Horses competing in Elementary, Medium or Advanced Medium classes during this series cannot compete in Preliminary classes.
- 13 Horses may only compete in a maximum of three classes on any one day if space permits.
- 14 In February, if a competitor who has already qualified at Preliminary or Novice qualifies at a higher level, their qualifying place at the lower level will be filled by the next horse/rider combination from the February competition.

## NORTH EAST RIDING CLUB DRESSAGE CHAMPIONSHIPS

1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> placed horse and rider combinations in the qualifying classes throughout the dressage series will qualify for the Championships – disregarding those already qualified. Only qualifying horse and rider combinations may take part in the Championships which will take place on March 6, 2010.

### ATTENTION NERC MEMBERS: POINTS LEAGUE

NERC members are allocated points for places in the QUALIFYING classes throughout the Dressage Series (6 points for 1<sup>st</sup>, 5 for 2<sup>nd</sup> etc.).

At the end of the qualifying competitions of the series (ie after the February competition), the points will be totalled and trophies, rosettes and prizes for the top three members at each level will be awarded at the NERC AGM in October. **Rosettes and prizes are kindly sponsored by Fountain Tack Shop.**

### ATTENTION ALL COMPETITORS: LEAVING THE ARENA

Please note that the new British Dressage rule about leaving the arena *at an appropriate place*, will be used for this Dressage Series. Even if the test instructs the rider to *leave at A*, please leave the arena at an appropriate place. Riders will NOT be penalised after the final salute, wherever they leave the arena, as judging ends after the halt/salute. Commanders will also not be penalised for reading from older copies of tests.

# HEALTH & SAFETY

---

1. The Organiser has the overall responsibility for Health and Safety.
2. The event is organised in accordance with Health and Safety legislation and all who have (to any extent) control of premises or site at the event are responsible for ensuring that:

All riders must wear a hard hat to at least the minimum standard with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Hats marked EN1384, PAS015, ASTM F1163, BSEN14572 or SEI. Riders are expected to behave in a responsible manner at all times or they may face elimination.
6. Dogs

Dogs must be kept under close control and on leads at all times.
