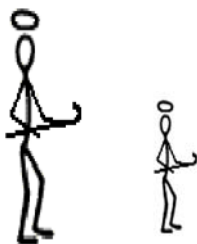

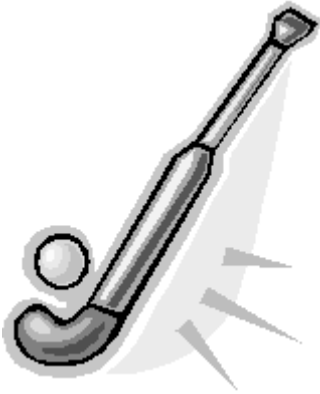

ST. NEOTS HOCKEY CLUB RULES

Revised April 2000

- 1) The club shall be called **ST. NEOTS HOCKEY CLUB**.
- 2) The Club shall comprise Ladies, Men's and Youth sections

The Club colours shall be:

Shirts	Light Blue
Short/Skirts	Dark Blue
Socks	Light Blue with Dark Blue hoops

All members shall play in club colours.

- 3) The sections shall play under the current rules of the appropriate Hockey Associations. Each section shall be affiliated to a County Hockey Association.
- 4) Two Committees shall be formed from the members:

The General Committee and **The Playing Committee**.

The General Committee of the Club shall comprise the Chairperson, Secretary, Treasurer, Men's Fixture Secretary, Ladies Fixture Secretary, Club Captain, Commercial Officer and Youth Development Officer.

The General Committee shall be responsible for the management of the Club on behalf of the members. In particular it shall be responsible for:

- ★ Overall development objectives, and policy;
- ★ Financial management and control;
- ★ Ensuring that the club plays under the current rules of the appropriate Hockey Associations to which the club is affiliated; and
- ★ Disciplinary policy.

The Playing Committee of the Club will be chaired by the Club Captain and comprise of the Team Captains of all playing sides. The Club Captain shall not be a Team Captain.

The Playing Committee shall be responsible for the management of the playing objectives and policy of the Club on behalf of the members. In particular it will be responsible for:

- ★ Agreeing the playing strategy and objectives with the General Committee;
- ★ Training matters and arrangements;
- ★ Selection policy; and

★ Management of the disciplinary policy.

5) Both the General Committee and the Playing Committee shall have the power to co-opt.

6) Both Committees shall organise the business of its own meetings, subject to the overall control and direction of the General Committee.

7) The first meeting of both Committees shall be held before the 31st July of each playing season.

8) The General Committee shall have the power to form sub-committees.

9) The General Committee shall have powers to deal with all matters other than those mentioned in the rules.

10) A quorum of the General Committee shall be four and of the Playing Committee shall be five of their respective members.

11) An Annual General Meeting (AGM) shall be held within four weeks of the official end of each season. One fifth of the total membership shall form a quorum. Members shall be given not less than seven days notice of the date of an AGM.

12) At the AGM all officers of the Club shall be elected. All Nominations must be Proposed and Seconded by a Club Member. In the event of more than one nomination for a post there will be a 'show of hands' to decide the winner. Only current Club members shall be eligible to vote.

All committee positions shall be re-elected each year. The post of Honorary President shall be re-elected every three years.

13) No alterations shall be made to these rules except at the AGM or an Extraordinary General Meeting convened at the request of at least six members, in writing. The Secretary shall be given at least 14 days notice of such a meeting and the proposed alterations.

14) Members participating in matches shall pay a match fee as decided by the General Committee.

15) Annual subscriptions shall be decided at the AGM. Members whose subscriptions are in arrears shall not be selected to play. New players shall not be deemed to be Club members until they have participated in three matches at which time they will become eligible to pay the appropriate subscription.

16) If the conduct of any member be unsatisfactory the General Committee shall have the power to demand their resignation or take such disciplinary action as the Committee decides. The General Committee's decision in such matters is final.

17) A copy of these rules shall be issued to every member of the Club.

DISCIPLINARY POLICY

- 1) The overall aim of the policy is to:
 - a) Encourage good conduct when representing the Club on/off the field.
 - b) Provide a framework for dealing equably with disciplinary incidents.
- 2) The procedure only applies to members of the Club and only members should play. Membership consists of paying the annual subscription.
- 3) Before, during and after matches (including travel), at training and social events, etc. members are representing SNHC and the Club will be judged by how they act. All members are ambassadors for the Club.
- 4) Team discipline on the field is the primary responsibility of the team captains.
- 5) Indiscipline on the field shall be dealt with by the Captain/Club Captain:
 - a) **Green Card** a word of caution to the offender.
 - b) **Yellow Card** stronger word of caution plus a penalty or fine.
 - c) **Red Card** disciplinary meeting plus a penalty/fine.
- 6) The Club Secretary must be informed of all players receiving either a Red or Yellow Card.
 - a) **Minor** e.g. non-violent conduct, swearing, spitting - verbal warning by team or Club Captain. Repeated offences may require a more serious penalty.
 - b) **Non-minor** e.g. aggravated or threatening behaviour, verbal or racist abuse, report from another club - written warning from the Club Secretary and possibly team demotion and/or match ban.
 - c) **Serious** e.g. violent conduct, fighting, theft - written warning from the Club Secretary and disciplinary meeting.
- 7) A disciplinary meeting shall be held for red cards and serious incidents or if repeated offences necessitate a strong response. The meeting should include the offender, Club Captain, team captain (if appropriate) and an impartial member of St. Neots HC Committee. The meeting should determine the facts and decide an appropriate penalty taking into account any league requirements. The output should be:
 - a) Written report of the circumstances and action taken which should be copied to the relevant league secretary (where appropriate).
 - b) A punishment fitting for the offence.

EH GUIDE TO PITCHSIDE CONDUCT

(The following is a guide published by England Hockey for appropriate behaviour of club officials, players and supporters during cup games. The committee would like St Neots players to behave as if the following were in force during league games).

It is the responsibility of the clubs to ensure that good manners and courtesy prevail towards the opposition, umpires and other officials before, during and after the game. Once the pitch is available, the Match Delegate (if appointed) or home Captain shall assume authority for the pitch and its surrounding area. Clubs are advised to ensure that they have adequate insurance cover and that they are aware of local health and safety legislation regarding pitch and facilities.

Captains, Umpires and Match Delegates (if appointed) should:

- 1) Agree the location of managers, coaches, substitutes and suspended players during their suspension and from where substitutions will take place.
- 2) Satisfy themselves as to the quality and safety of the pitch and its facilities and ensure that other pitch side furniture is removed to the safest location.
- 3) Check the availability and location of an emergency telephone and first aid.
- 4) Agree with home team officials the location and allowed proximity of spectators.
- 5) **Substitutes should warm up in clothing in a colour other than the participating teams in agreed area of the pitch side.**
- 6) Coaches and managers must remain in their designated area.
- 7) **Vocal communication by team officials and players on the bench must not, in any way, be directed at the umpires or players of the opposing team.**
- 8) **Players not taking part in the game, or those in subsequent or previous matches, must not knock up or cool down on or near the pitch whilst the match is in progress.**
- 9) Post match inquests should be held away from the pitch.
- 10) **Spectators should be advised, if necessary, of matters relating to their conduct and particularly in so far as this affects the game in hand.**
- 11) Small children should not be allowed to wander freely around the perimeter of the pitch whilst games are in progress. Children should remain under the control of the parent/guardian at all times.
- 12) Babies in push chairs should not be left parked on the side of the pitch.
- 13) **Captains, coaches and managers should be responsible for their own conduct and the conduct of their players at all times.**

CLUBS 1st ACCREDITATION

Clubs 1st is an England Hockey accreditation scheme, which recognises the club is run to nationally defined standards. All clubs achieving Clubs 1st also achieve Sport England Clubmark, a recognised award for well-run sports clubs. We are aiming for Clubs 1st accreditation for St Neots Hockey Club. This entails a formalisation of our procedures and practises for training, child protection, accidents and injuries, etc. to make sure we provide a safe, effective and child-friendly hockey environment. All members should be aware of their responsibilities, when these procedures have been put in place. All documentation will be found on the dedicated Clubs 1st page of our web site. Child Protection

St Neots Hockey Club believes:

- it is important to protect and promote the safety and welfare of children.
- all children have a right to be protected from abuse, whether physical, sexual or emotional.
- the rights, dignity and worth of a child should always be protected.
