St. Neots Girls U15 team played their first matches on 29th October and came away winners.

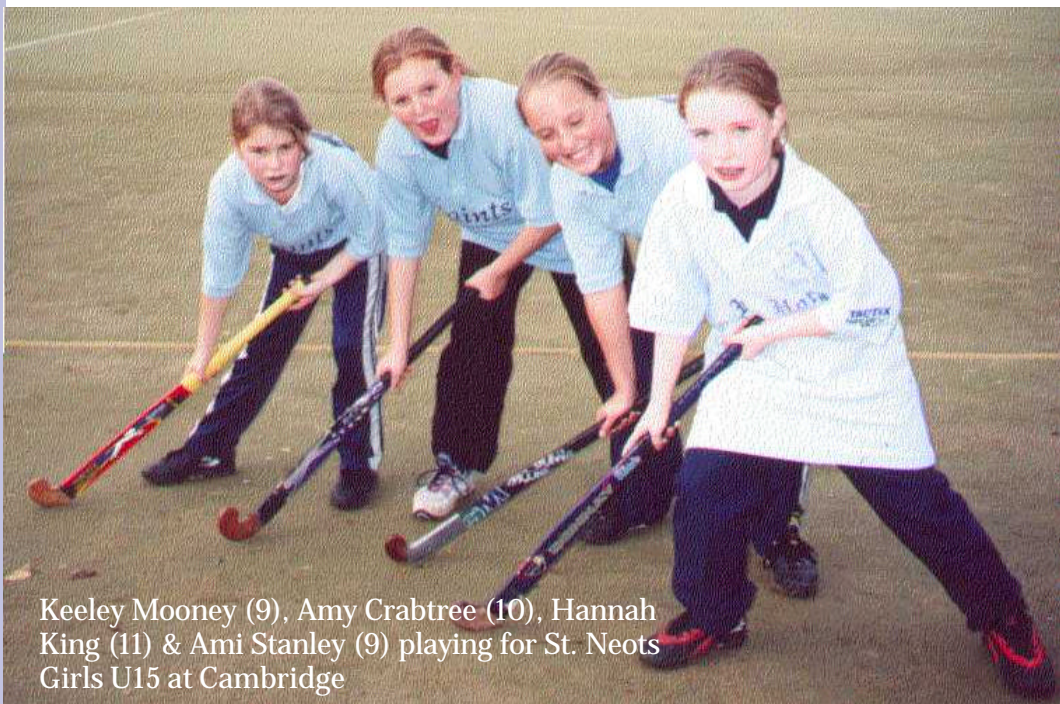
