Minor Puppy Dog: (4). **1.** Easdon and Martin's, Yakee a Shared Moment. Super pale fawn with black face. Excellent condition throughout. Moved with correct role and presented to perfection. **2.** Shaw and Francis's, Cisfran Succession. Nice size not too big, cobby body with plenty of substance. When settled moved well. **3.** Offiler's, StSanja For Sure.

Puppy Dog: (5). **1.** Smith's, Palacegarden McCafferty. Smart red puppy. Head finishing well. Plenty of bone and substance. Nice size. Moved well, most promising. **2.** Debenham's, Yingu Domingo. Handsome boy shown in well presented coat. Good body with excellent head and expression. Just preferred the front of the winner. **3.** Easden and Martin's, Yakee Reaction.

Junior Dog: (5). **1.** Smith's, Palacegarden Murphy. Another completely sound young dog as are all from this kennel. Well constructed throughout. Excellent presentation. Moved correctly. **2.** Mead's, Delwin's Irish Charmer at Sukime. Very good head and expression. Nice full eye, open nostrils, correct under jaw. Good body, just preferred movement of the winner on the day.

Novice Dog: (1). **1.** Shaw and Francis's, Pekehuis Simply by Design. Stunning puppy with fabulous head, open negroid nostrils, correct underjaw. Tremendous body slung between four boned legs. Moved with correct roll. Prepared and presented to absolute perfection. CC, BIS and BPIS.

Graduate Dog: (2). **1.** Collinson's, Ferara Domino of Savico. Perfectly marked black and white parti coloured. Well presented with good solid body. When settled moved well. **2.** Matthews', Yorklee Pearly Prince of Yarmray. Handsome boy with nice shallow head. Moved steadily. Good harsh top coat.

Post Graduate Dog: (11). **1.** Offiler's, StSanja Tu Step. Smart young dog which must be handled to be appreciated. Lots of bone and substance. Short shapely body. Lovely head and expression. Prepared and presented to perfection. Gave him much consideration for the RCC, sure his day will come. **2.** Hughes's, Creewood Georgi Boi at Sacgika. Well made young dog not overdone in any way. Nice size. Completely sound. Well presented. **3.** Debenham's, Jidoran Jacob Yingu.

Limit Dog: (8). **1.** Easden and Martin's, Yakee a Sight for Sore Eyes. So well named he really is a sight for sore eyes. Fabulous presentation and movement. Completely sound. Handled to get the best out of him. Sure to go all the way. **2.** Furey's, Bramblefireds 'Enry Higgins. Excellent head and expression. Picks up heavy. Plenty of bone and substance. Correct movement. Well presented. **3.** Morley and Box's, Jidorn II Divo.

Open Dog: (4). **1.** Smith's, Palacegarden Donovan. Well constructed chunky red dog. Correct size, picks up heavy. Good in both coats sure to go all the way. **2.** Charlton's, Ch. Brentoy Red Adair. Very handsome boy in full coat, so well angulated throughout. Beautiful well presented coat. Moved with correct roll. Handled to get the best out of him. **3.** Morley and Box's, Ch. Jidoran El Cid.

Minor Puppy Bitch: (9). **1.** Thomas's, Jonsville Now Your Taking. Super silver brindle puppy. Head finishing well. Cobby body slung between four good legs. Well presented has a great future. **2.** Shipley's, Kettlemere Solitaire. Very glamorous pale fawn puppy with black mask. Must be handled to be appreciated. Lovely well presented puppy coat. Short and compact. Good topline. Nice head and eye. **3.** Warren's, Renwars Black Pearl.

Puppy Bitch: (11). **1.** Charlton's, Brentoy Wild Cards. Sweet head and expression. Short cobby body. Plenty of substance for size. Well presented, moved well. **2.** Offiler's, Swankipause Spinn' Around at StSanja. Close up to the winner, sure to change places in the future. Another star from this kennel. Fabulous presentation, just felt that the winner went better on the day. **3.** Collinson's, Ferara Fantasy.

Junior Bitch: (3). **1.** Shaw, Francie and Mee's, Pekehuis Samantha. Well made red brindle. Low to ground, lots of substance. Moved correctly. Just coming back into adult coat. **2.** Palmer's, Dratsum Melody at Karakara. Well made fawn bitch with self coloured face. Excellent body. Moved with correct roll. Well presented.

Maiden Bitch: (4). **1.** Warren's, Renwars She's the One. Smart chunky red bitch. Very good head and expression. Cobby body, plenty of bone and substance. Moved well. **2.** Dratsum Melody at Karakara. **3.** Ferara Fantasy.

Novice Bitch: (4). **1.** Thomas's, Jonsville Touch of a Rumour. Cracking grey brindle with black mask. Head finishing well. Picked up heavy. When settled moved well. Something special. **2.** Dratsum Melody at Karakara. **3.** Thomas's Mrs A P.

Graduate Bitch: (4). **1.** Robertshaw's, Lotusgrange Red Queen. Chunky red bitch with good head and eye. Solid body. In-between coats. Moved well. **2.** Summer's, Dratsum Midnight Belle. Lovely black bitch. Excellent head with open features. Plenty of substance. Solid body but needs more ring training. **3.** Dixon and Penman's, Dragden Queen Bee.

Post Graduate Bitch: (7). **1.** Whitehead's, StSanja Wow at Weesann. Old favourite of mine with lovely shallow head, nice full eye and plenty of substance. Just coming back into good coat. Moved with correct roll. Presented the best I have seen her. **2.** Summers', Dratsum Katie Coaldust. Shown in excellent condition. Nice open features. Solid body. Lots of substance. Coat in excellent condition. Handler needs more training.

Limit Bitch: (6). **1.** Dixon and Pneman's, Singewell Trinny at Dragden. Fabulous bitch which must be handled to be appreciated. Complete balance throughout. Could not get passed her on the day. CC and RBIS. **2.** Grant's, Sushima the Temptress. Close up to the winner. Grey brindle with black face. Excellent topline and head, picks up heavy. Moved with correct roll, sure her day will come. **3.** Hitt's, Nosredna Summer Rose at Miracey.

Open Bitch: (5). **1.** Goodall's, Shingo Queen of Gossip. Another from the top drawer built on good clean lines with a super head and expression. Tremendous body and bone. Moved correctly. Excellent presentation. RCC. **2.** Easden and Martin's, Ch. Yakee of Noble Birth. Cracking bitch. Prepared and presented to perfection. Solid body with plenty of substance. Handled to get the best out of her. Worthy Champion. **3.** Shaw and Francis's, Cisfran Dream Ticket.

Veteran Dog or Bitch: (4). **1.** Dixon and Penman's, Dragden Pied Piper. Attractive parti coloured bitch who looked so good for age. Excellent movement and presentation. **2.** Ferguson and Claridge's, Singlewell Heligan. Nice shallow head with full eye. Moved steadily. Close up to winner.

Special Open Black, Black with White or Tan: (3). **1.** Robertshaw's, Supersuade of Lotusgrange. Cracking black dog. Completely sound. Very good head and eye. Nice size. Moved with correct roll. **2.** Dratsum Midnight Belle. **3.** Dratsum Katie Coaldust.

Special Open White, Cream or Particolour: (2). **1.** Dragden Piped Piper. **2.** Ferara Domino Savico

Special Open Fawn or Grey Brindle: (4). **1.** Wilkins', Ravencrest Alfie Moon. **2.** Jarvis's, Incana Midnight Mischief at Utoo Sh CM. Very sound with nice open features. Moved well, would like him shorter in loin. **3.** Wilkins', Ravenscrest Oscar.

Special Open Red or Red Brindle: (4). **1.** Hughes's, Shiarita the Red Baron at Sachiko. Well constructed throughout. Nice size. Good body slung between four good legs. Moved well. **2.** McGinley's, Nosredna Ho Soluck. Shown in excellent condition. Correct coat texture. Solid body. Just preferred front of the winner.
