## One Day Knock-out - June 2008

This event is a Windsor round for the seniors and a national round for the juniors, every dozen during the day the scores for that dozen are given to Brenda and Peter who calculate a handicap score for that dozen. The system of handicap scores means that a longbow can be against a compound. Then after the first draw you shoot on the same target as your opponent, and the winner has the best score (on handicap). The loser continues the round but is asked to shoot on the targets on the edge of the field layout.

At the end we have 2 seniors shooting against each other and hopefully 2 juniors against each other. The prize is a cut glass bowl for the seniors and an engraved glass trophy for the juniors.

This years event was quite evenly matched with Jim Mercer-Chalmers coming out the winner in the senior competition and Michael Murray the under 10 winner and Scott Wigmore the over 10 winner well done to them.
