## COACH LICENCE RENEWALS

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR LEVEL 1 COACHES

There is a new process in place for the renewal of Level 1 coaches; this came in to effect on the 1<sup>st</sup> January 2007.

The Level 1 Coach will receive the following renewal paperwork:

- A covering letter
- Coach Renewal Application form CR01 (copy attached)
- CPD Matrix (copy attached)
- Quick Guide for Coach Applicants (copy attached)
- CRB Form
- A sealed envelope addressed: "To the Club official"

The Coach Renewal Application form is to be completed using the CPD Matrix and Quick Guide as required. The work record on page 2 has to be signed off by the nominated referee(s). Please note: A Coach or County Coach who is on a Renewal Panel **can** be a referee for a Level 1 Coach at their Club. **The form is then to be sent to the Chairman of the Level 1 Renewal Panel for their County.**

**CCO's - Please ensure that the Level 1 Coaches in your area know the address of who to send the Renewal form to.**

In addition the Renewal Form, CPD Matrix and Quick Guide are also available on the GNAS Website: Coaching > Information page.

The CRB Form is to be completed as per the instructions that will come with it and once signed off by the CPO or Club Officer it is to be sent back to GNAS Office.

The sealed envelope is to be given to the Club CPO or if the club does not have an appointed CPO the Club Secretary.
