BO EGM & Future of Orienteering conference


British Orienteering has called an EGM for Saturday 27th October to discuss/approve changes to its governance structure. The objective is to amend the Federation articles to change the governance of our sport from a current council of 21 to a board of around 9 or 10 member-elected directors. The intention is to simplify and make more accountable the decision making authority of our sport. The EGM will form part of a conference day devoted to discussing the future of orienteering and club development. This conference day is designed to consult members and clubs on competition structure proposals (fixtures) and a range of other matters.
